From Our Delegate: Area Highlights to be presented at the 57th Annual General Service Conference in NY

Area 93 has approximately 990 groups, making up 28 Districts. We are beginning our seventh year as Area 93 and we just completed our second area inventory and will be implementing some changes as a result of that process. We have 5 assemblies, a Pre-Conference Workshop and 5 Area Committee Meetings each year. Our Districts bid for the location of the assemblies and this is intended to keep us rotating throughout our area. At our assemblies, the mornings consist of new GSR orientation given by the Alternate Delegate and the GSR and DCM sharing sessions moderated by past delegates.

Then our committees meet. Our business is taken care of in the afternoon. We look to our Standing Committee Chairmen to be the backbone of all the 12th step work our Area can possibly think to do and they have always risen to the task. When we began Area 93, we started with some combined committees such as PI/Website/Accessibility and Literature/Audio Visual/ Newsletter.
